



APPLY TO GRADUATE

In order to be considered for a degree, all students must file an Application for Graduation. Degrees are awarded in October, February and May. Every candidate, regardless of graduation date, is invited to participant in Class Day and University Commencement. VERIFY DIPLOMA ADDRESS

Your diploma will be mailed to the Diploma Address listed in SSOL typically 6-8 weeks after graduation. A Diploma Address that is missing may result in a delay of receipt of your diploma. Please visit <u>SSOL</u> and ensure you have the correct Diploma Address listed. Take into account any moves you may do in the months following graduation. Please also note that a 'Mailing Address' or 'Permanent Address' is not a Diploma Address, it is its own category.

ORDER REGALIA

All graduates (October, February and May) who plan to attend the May graduation ceremonies must wear academic regalia to both the Mailman and all-university Commencement ceremonies. Graduates must purchase regalia from the Columbia University Bookstore. Online and in-store purchasing is available. MARCHINGORDER FOR NAME PRONUNCIATION & TICKETS

The Mailman School has partnered with MarchingOrder, an online service for both ticketing and name pronunciation. After spring break, eligible graduates will receive an email invitation to access their MarchingOrder account. Students will be prompted to submit both phonetics and voice recordings of their name to ensure their names are read aloud correctly at Class Day.

MarchingOrder will also serve as the ticketing platform for Mailman School of Public Health Class Day. Eligible graduates are able to request up to six (6) guest tickets for the Mailman School of Public Health Class Day Ceremony.
