
#### Hudson Yards

Just as Mrs. Brown finished explaining HIV, they drove past the Stonewall Inn, a gay club that was raided in 1969. During this time, being part of the LGBTQ+ community was illegal and gay bar raids were routine for the NYPD. This was a major moment that mobilized the gay rights movement and the protests that followed.



"Protests erupted all around New York City and even in other states, like California. And it wasn't just people that were part of the community who participated, but allies as well. Even though they weren't part of the community, they chose to fight for the rights, health, and well-being of others that were not like them," Mrs. Brown explained.

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"This fight for justice, especially for marginalized communities, isn't something we see in the past. It happens over and over again, even today," Mrs. Brown adds.

"Just like how lies and misinformation hurt the LGBTQ+ community with HIV, we saw the same thing happen to the Asian community during COVID-19."



### Card's Back:

**You have obligations to your patients beyond treating their pathologies! For non-citizen patients:**

1. Do be aware of your patients' **political determinants of health**; it is your obligation to stay up to date with policies and laws that help preserve their well-being.
2. Do not let immigration enforcement officers access clinical premises if they don't have a **warrant signed by a judge**.
3. Do not disclose your patients' immigration status to anyone. *This is PHI protected under HIPAA.*
4. Do inform your patients of their rights and redirect them to appropriate resources (e.g. red cards).
5. Do seek out legal expertise to help protect your patients. Reach out to medical-legal partnerships!

#### Quick and Effective

Pink Cards offer busy clinicians a rapid overview of their duties and roles to uphold patients' constitutional rights.

The cards are the size of a credit card making them small enough to fit into a wallet or pocket allowing them to always be on hand.
