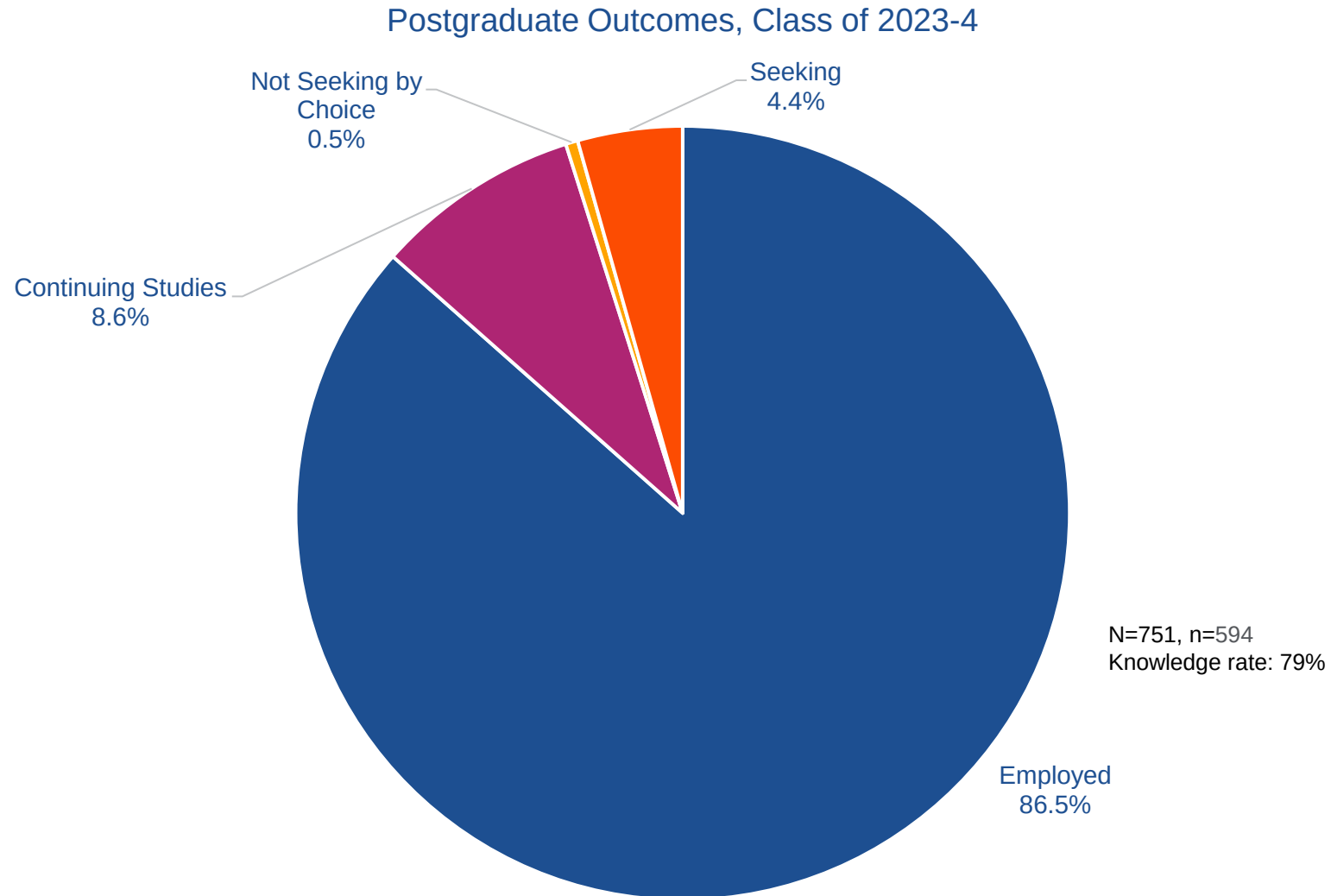

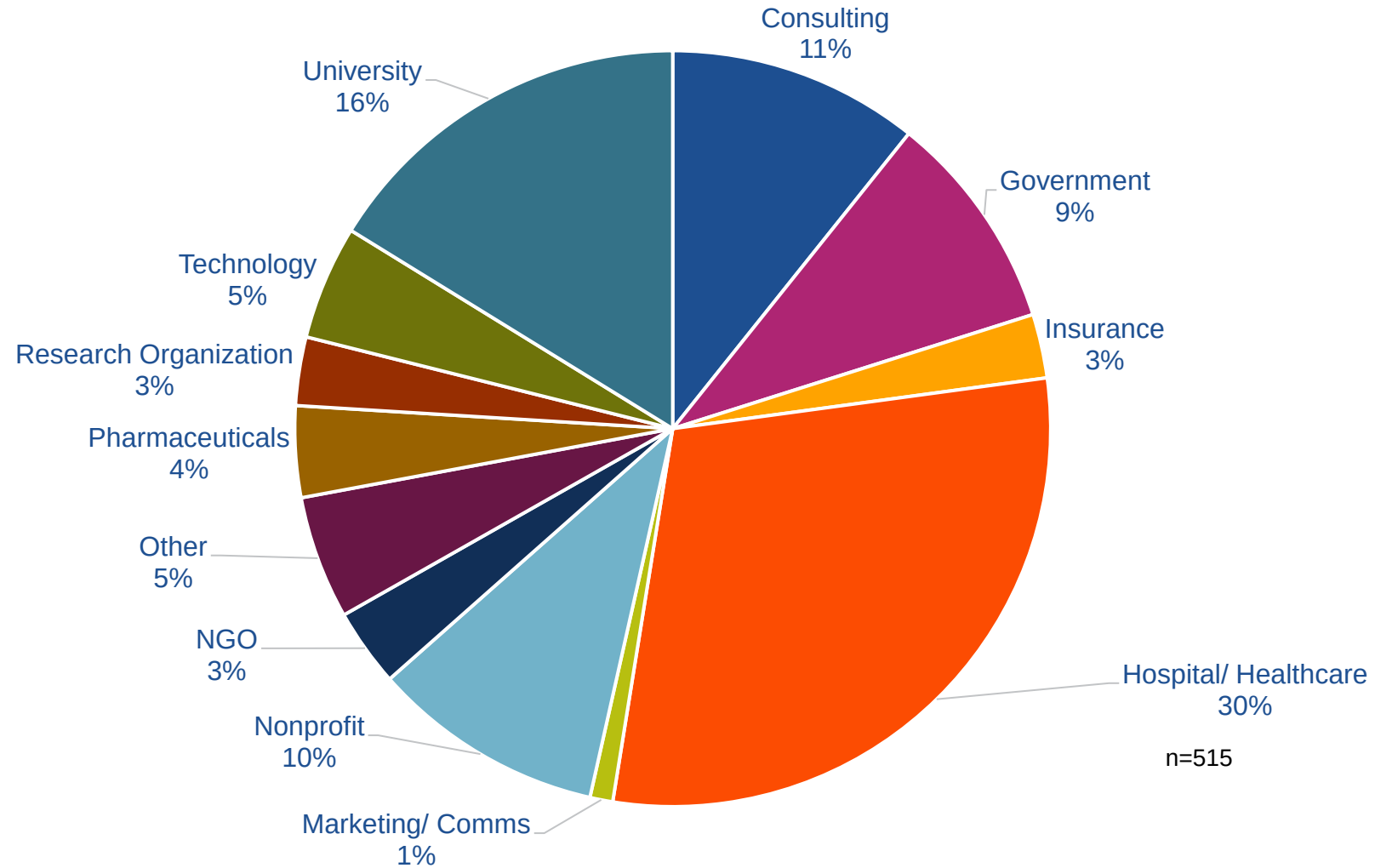

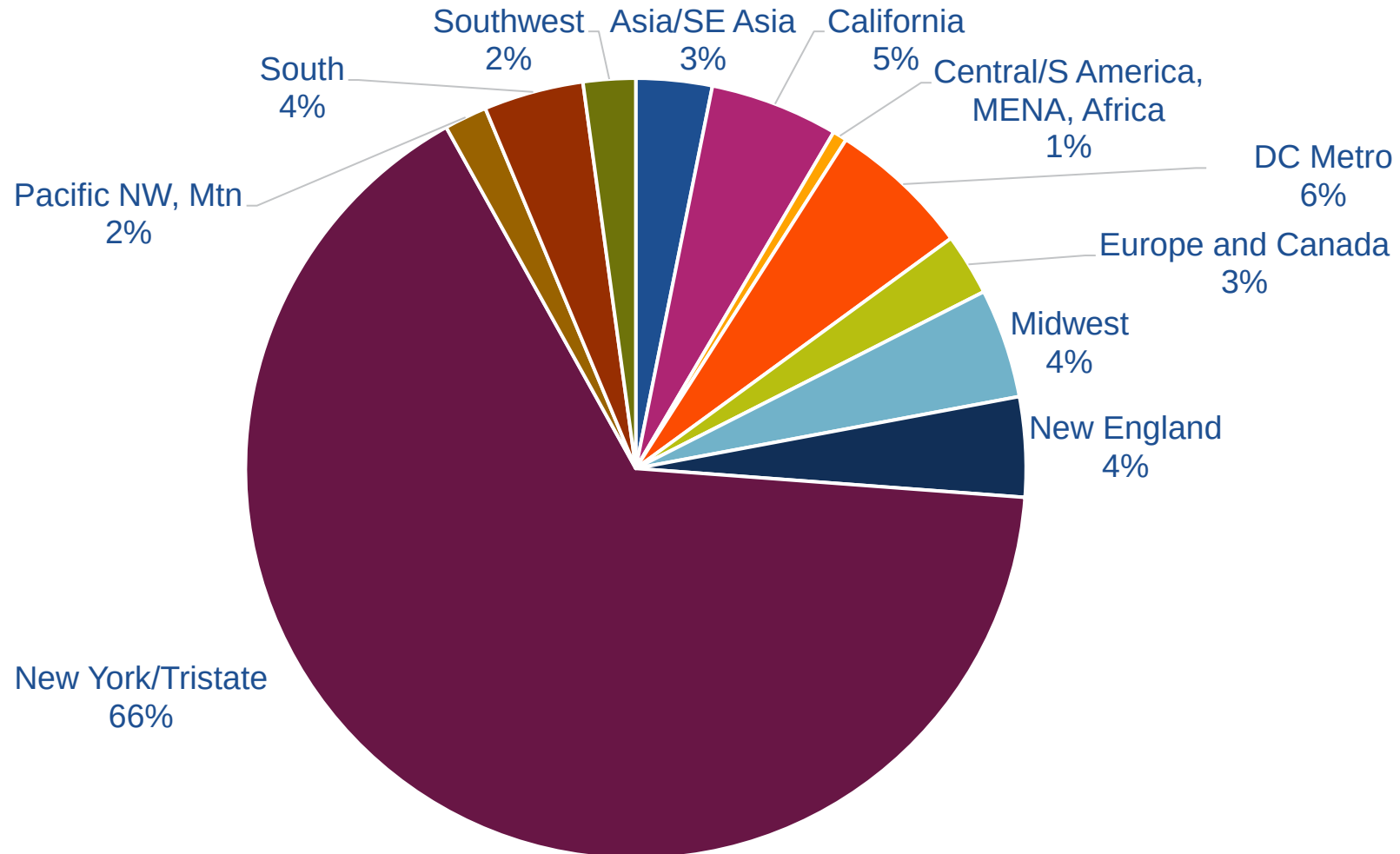

Job Search Process

- Average number of jobs graduates applied to: 55
- First round interviews: 4.9 average; Second round interviews: 3.4 average
- Job offers: 1.5 average (There were 3 students receiving 5 or more offers, 5 students receiving 4 offers; 17 students receiving 3 offers; and 41 students receiving 2 offers).
- 86% of employed graduates logged in to Mailman CareerLink job board at least once; only 70% of those who were still job-seeking had ever logged in
- Average number of career services appointments for employed graduates: 2.24; average logins: 19.5; for unemployed: 1.2 appts and 13.6 logins
- 80.2% of survey respondents used career services.

Overall Salaries

- 221 graduates reported salaries. Part-time salaries and international currency salaries were excluded.
- The Overall Average salary was: \$92,513 (for those with no prior graduate degree, \$81,256).
- The Overall Median salary was: \$75,000 (for those with no prior graduate degree, \$75,000).
- The range was \$35,000 to \$450,000.
- 38 graduates reported receiving bonuses, and the average bonus was \$15,528 and median bonus was \$8,175. Specific benefits/bonuses mentioned included tuition remission, stock options/equity, licensure reimbursement, visa sponsorship, housing and transportation pay (especially for graduates working internationally), and relocation costs.

Salary increase

For graduates who worked prior to attending Mailman School, and also provided salaries after graduation, the salary increase after graduation was:

\$39,732 average increase

\$28,000 median increase

Tow Doctoral Scholars Program

- Special mentorship and scholarship program for current Mailman Master's students or recent graduates; currently in 5th cohort
- Nominations due in late spring/early summer

Late summer-early December, participants receive:

- Faculty and alumni mentorship
- \$5,500 student stipend and \$3500 in discretionary funding for faculty mentor
- Biweekly support meetings and workshops
- Funding for PhD applications, conference attendance, GRE test prep

If accepted to PhD program at Mailman, each participant receives:

- \$50,000 per year for the first two years of PhD study to cover any costs associated
- with PhD study, including tuition (given to department)
- A \$3,000 “bonus” and \$3,000 for professional development to Tow Scholar PhD students for first two years of study

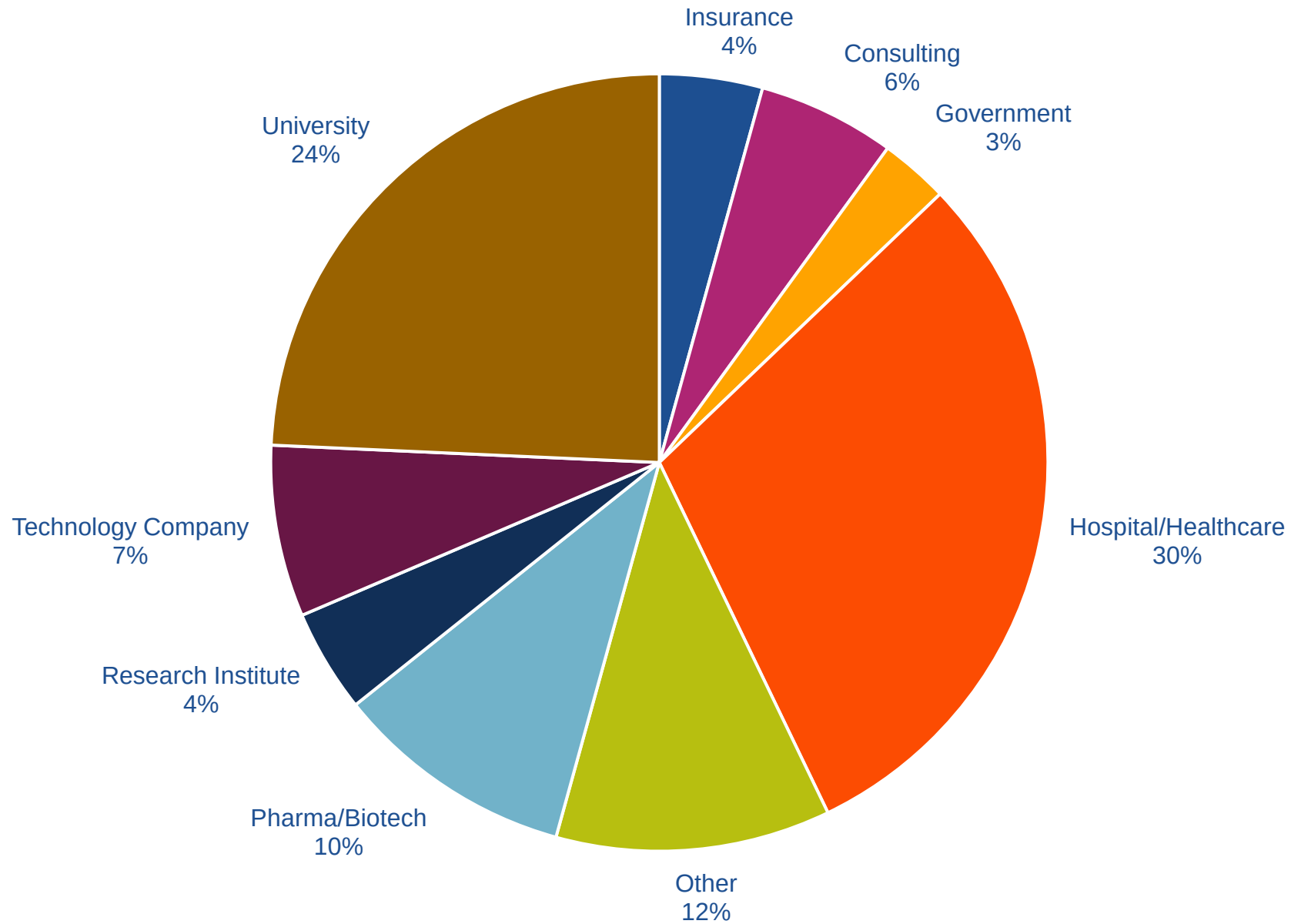

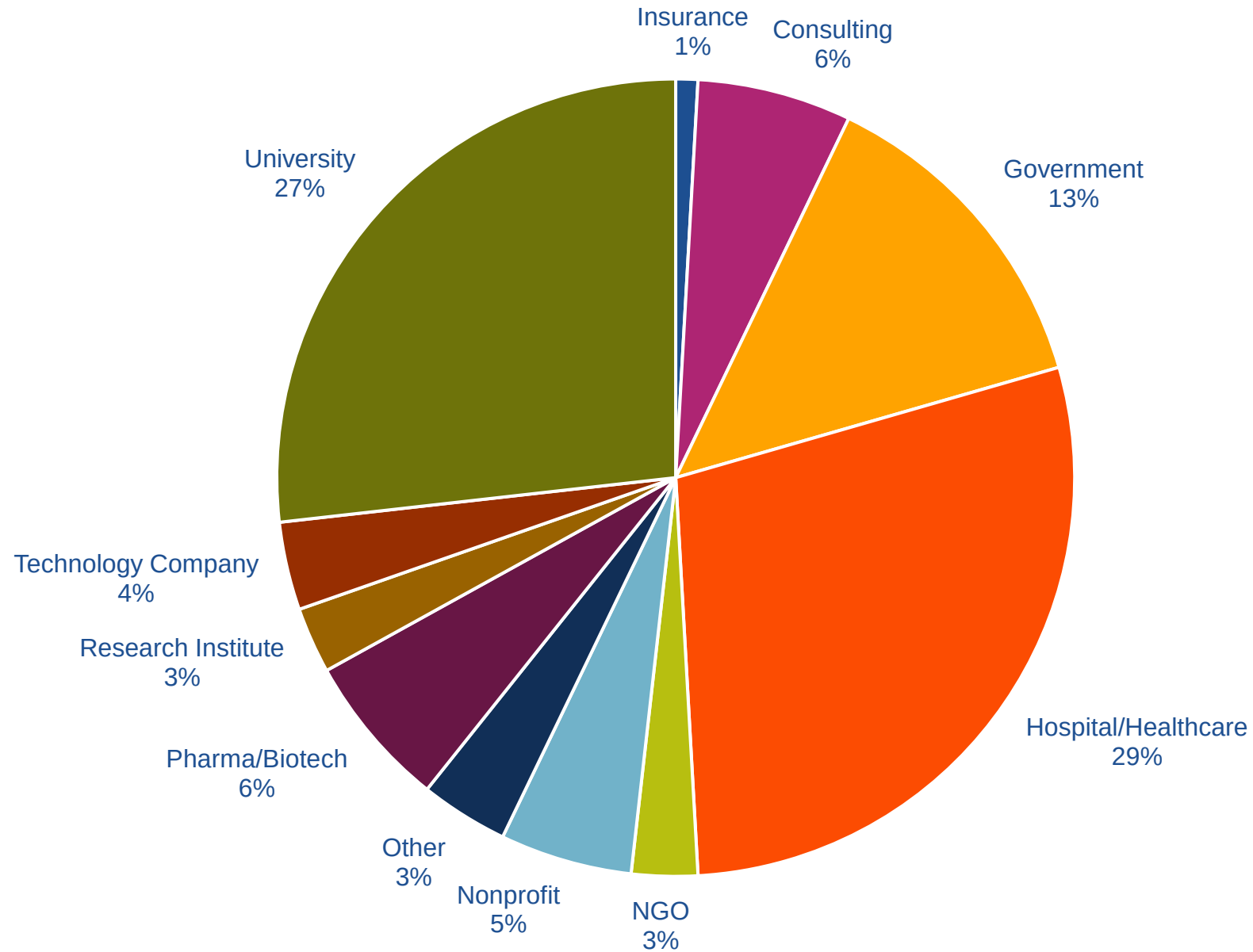

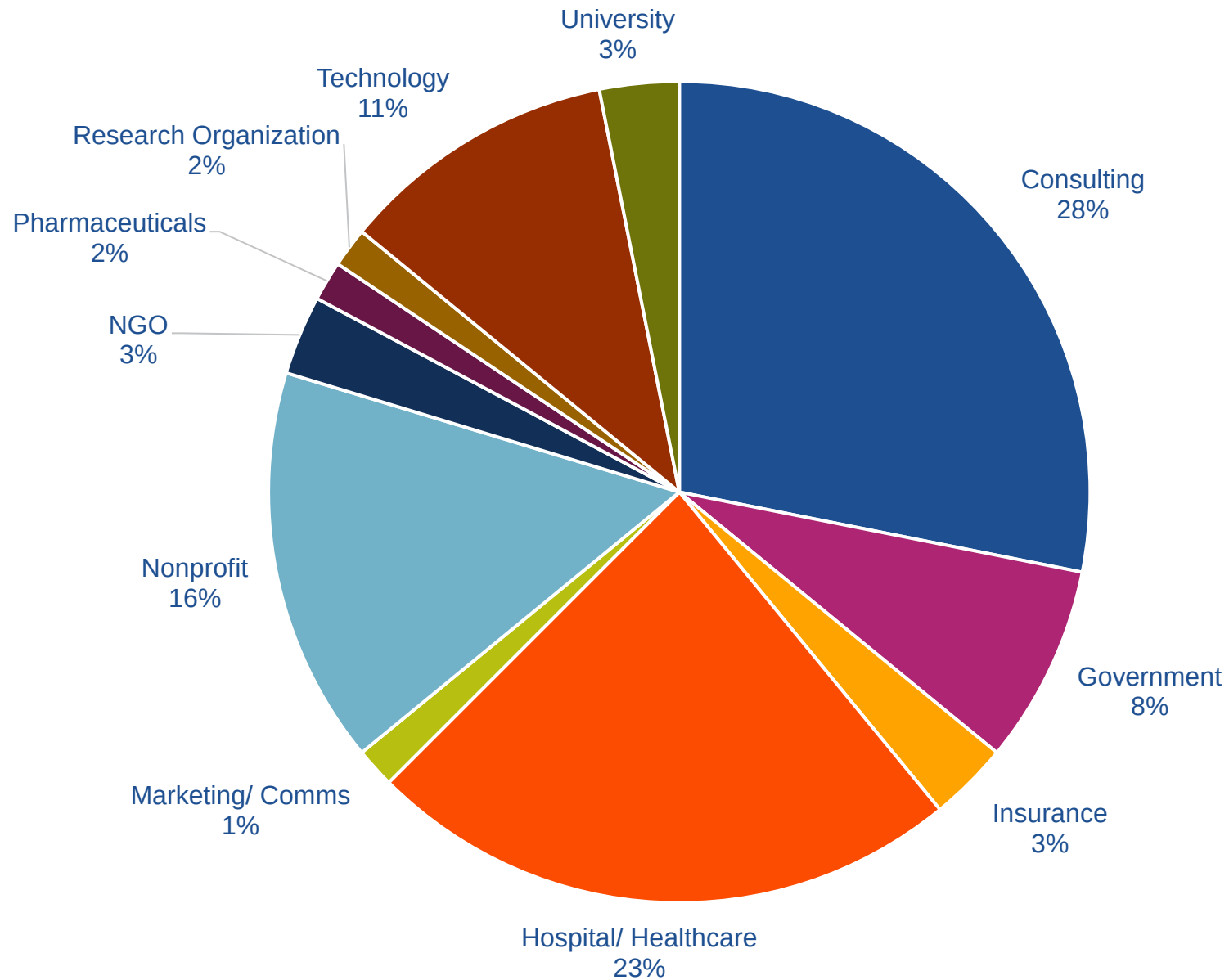

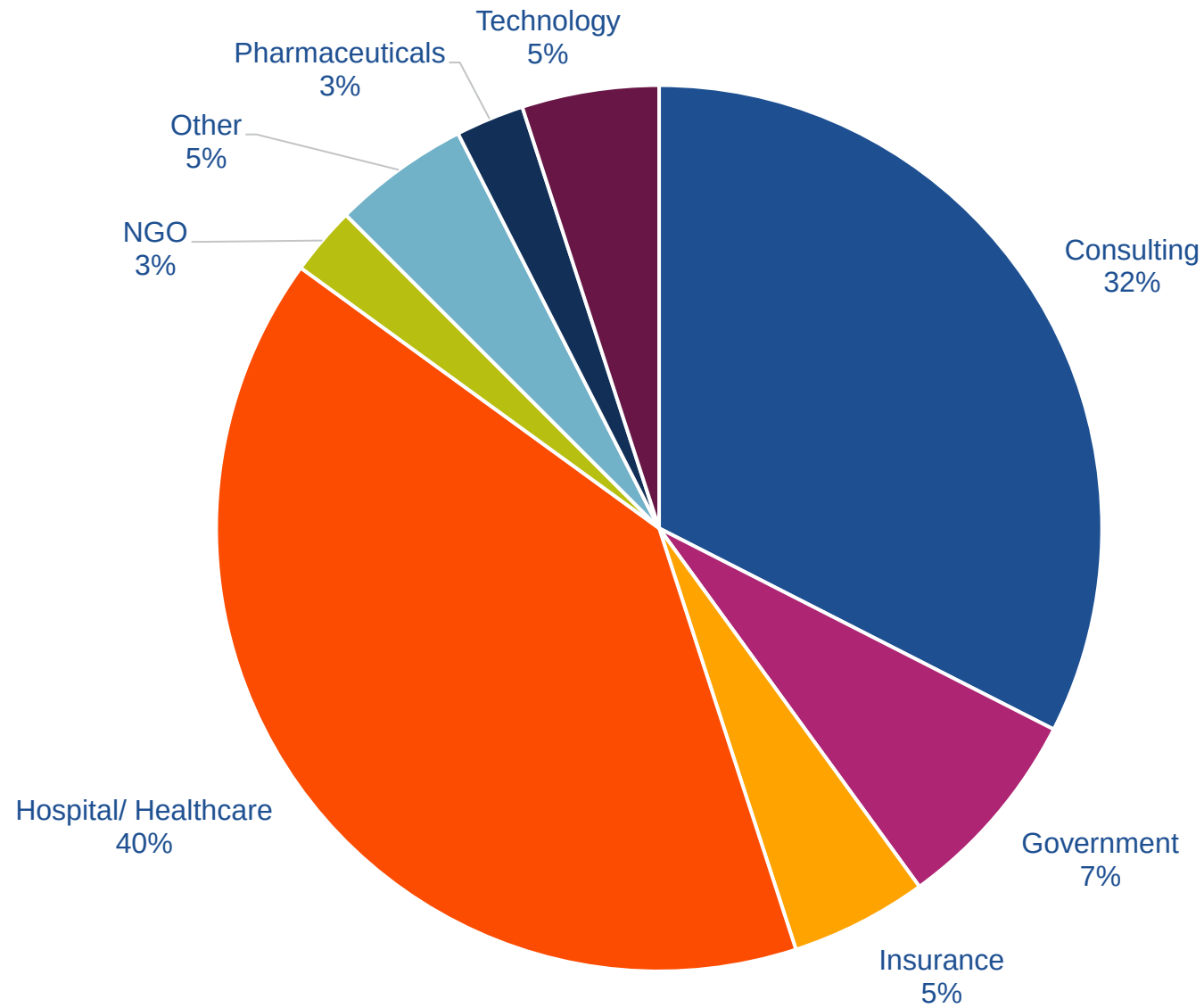
Health Policy & Management (N=189, n=151)

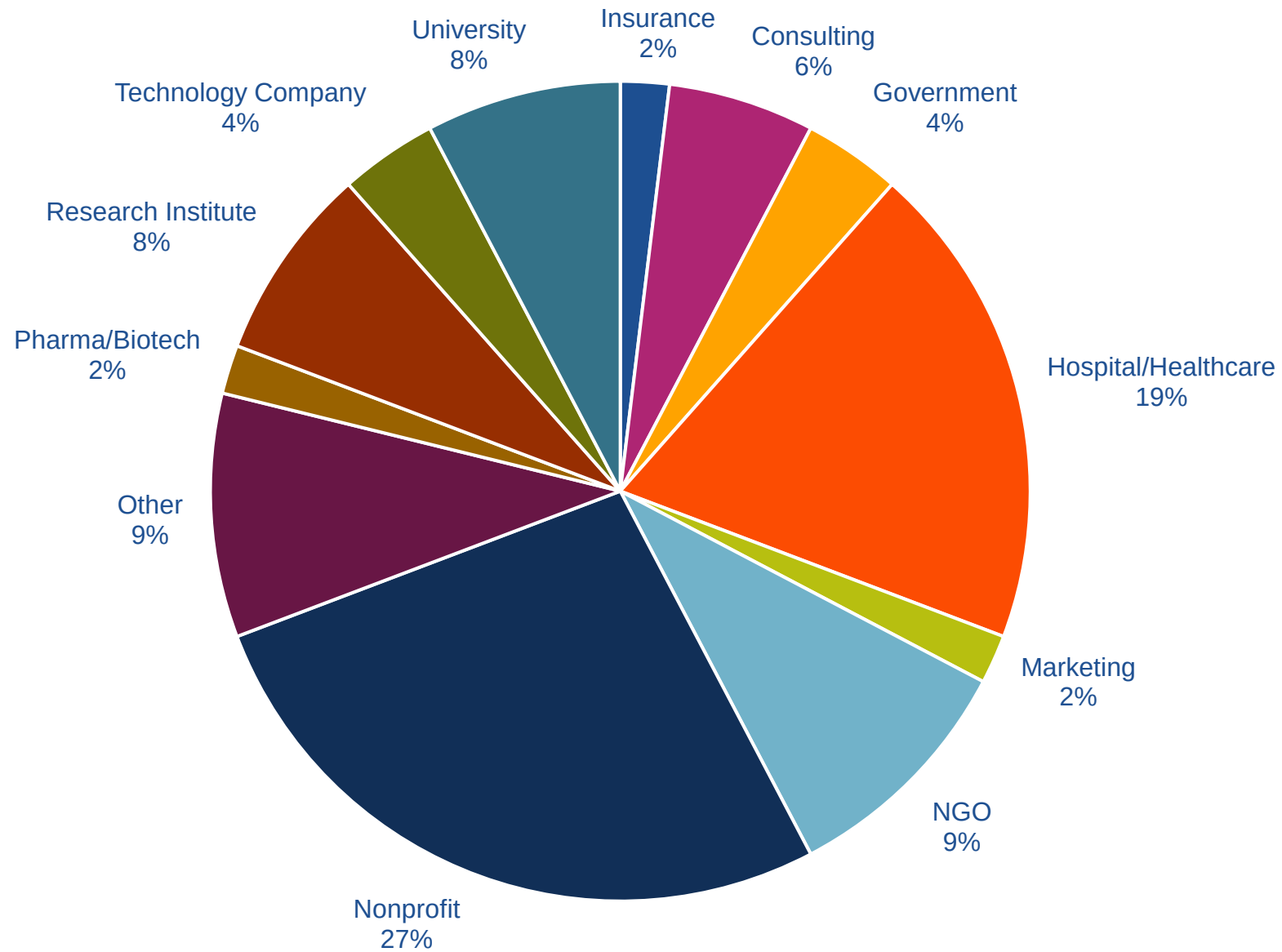

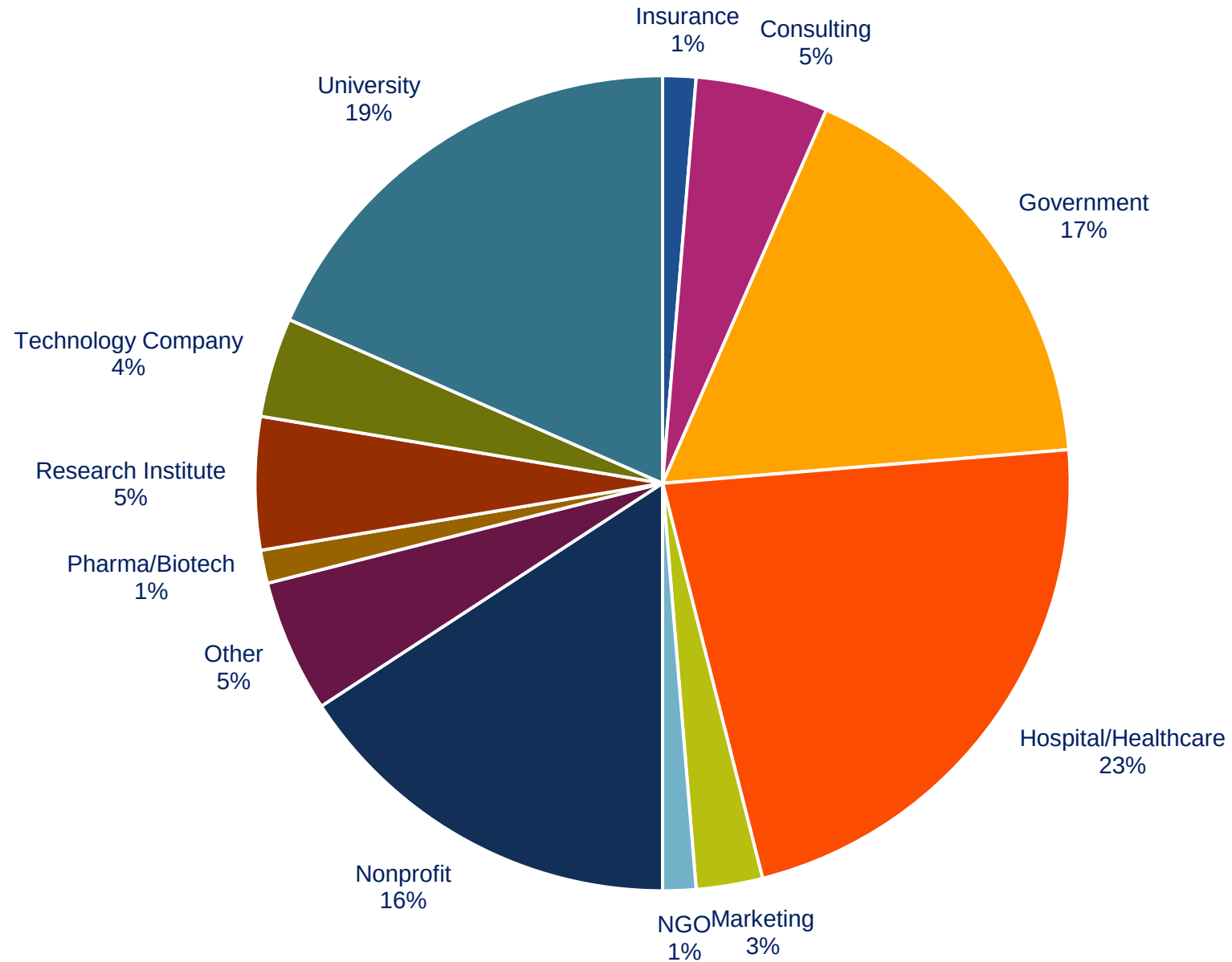

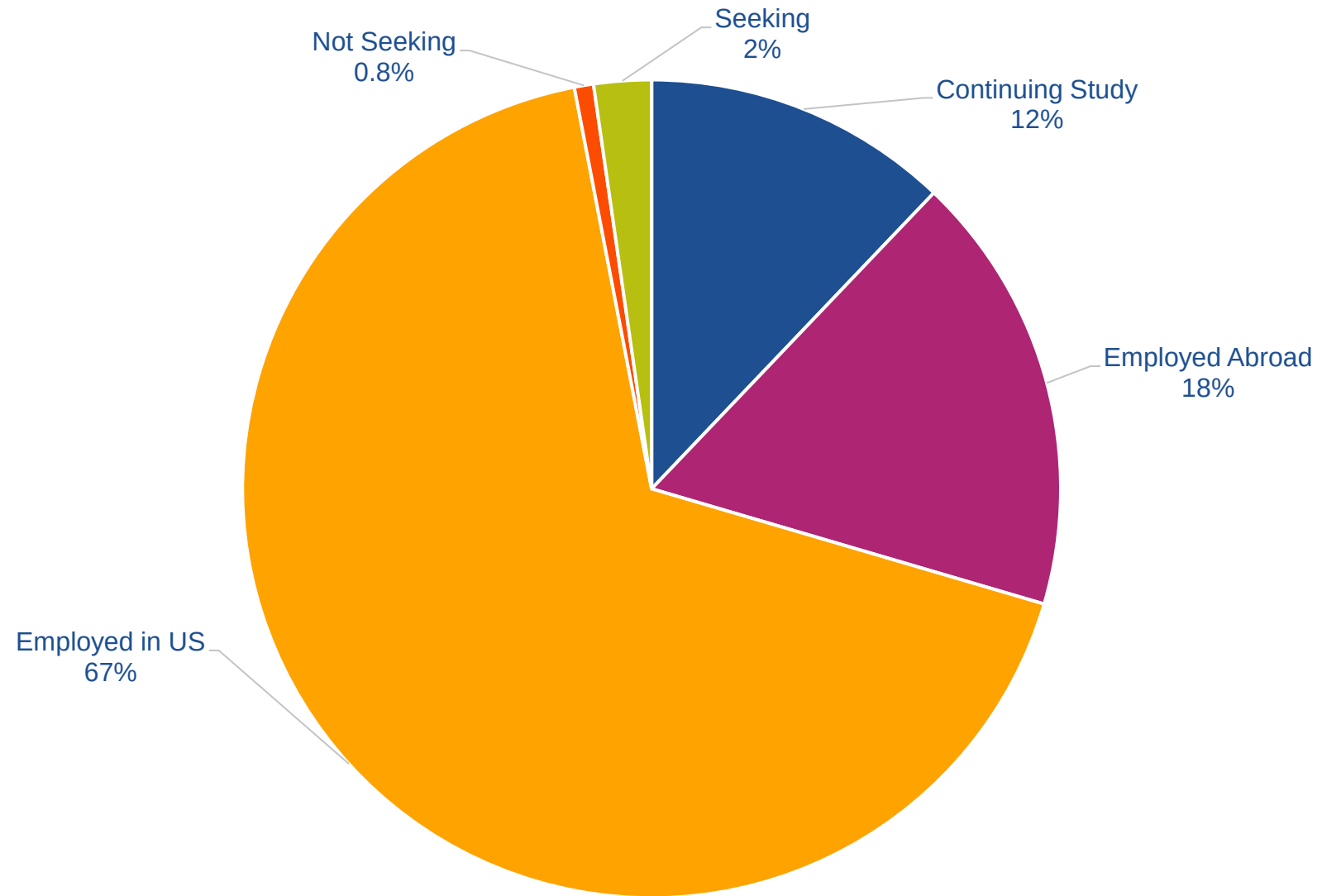
