Total Program Tuition & Fees

Executive Format (45 Credits)

- Approximately \$101K* Tuition
- Program Fee is ~\$12K (\$2K/semester) + ~\$5K School Fees



Part-Time Hybrid MHA Format (45.5 Credits)

- Approximately \$101K* Tuition
- Program + School Fees: ~\$7K

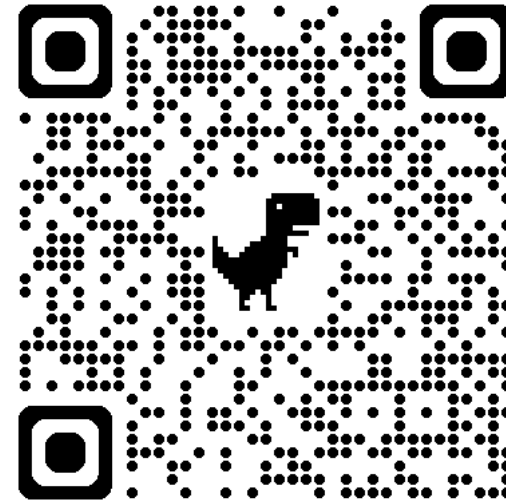
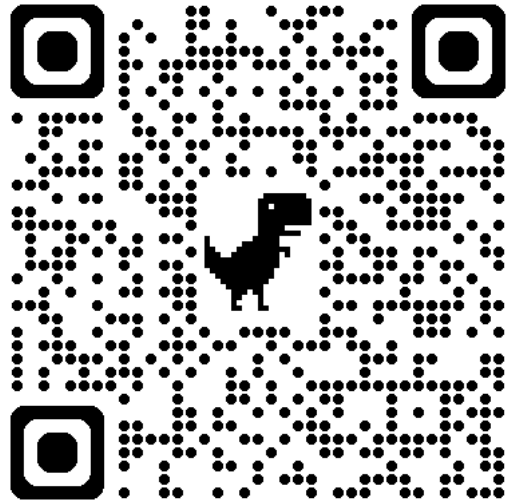
