Racial Justice & Equity

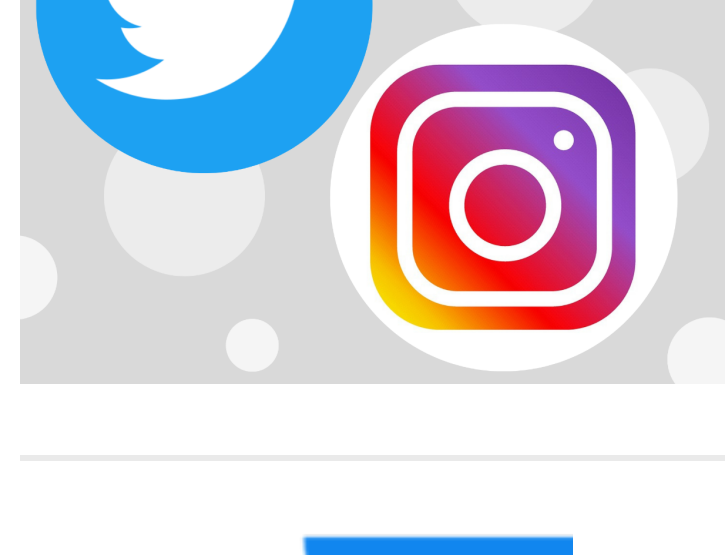
