### **D. Rights and Regulations**

1. What do you understand are the rights of patients in the health system?

- 3. What regulations are there regarding health worker performance? (Probe: district supervision policies?)
- 4. How are violations of these regulations identified and addressed? (Probe: what is the communication between health facilities and the districts in regards to violations of regulations? How are violations reported?)
- 5. Can you provide examples of ways that health workers are held accountable for their practice? What are the disciplinary measures that are used?
- 6. How commonly are these measures used?
- 7. How successful have these efforts been in changing practice?
- 8. What is the role of the health professional regulatory bodies (Tanzania Medical Council, Tanzania Nursing and Midwifery Council)? What is the role of health professional associations?

#### E. Understanding disrespect and abuse and its causes

- 1. What would you consider to be disrespectful or abusive care towards a patient?
- 2. Have you ever seen a patient experiencing disrespectful or abusive care from a health worker? What happened? What if anything did you do?
- 3. How common is disrespectful care or abusive towards patients? (Probe: specific for childbirth?)
- 4. Have any community members complained to you about the actions of health providers? Have you ever taken action on a complaint about a health provider from the community? What was done? What were the results?
- 5. Have you ever dealt with a case where a health provider was accused of abusive care? What was done? What were the results?
- 6. What do you think are the causes of disrespectful and abusive behavior? (Probe: between health workers and patients? Specific to childbirth?)

#### F. Recommendations

- 1. What would be your recommendations towards reducing/eliminating these types of disrespect and abuse at health facilities?
- 2. Who do you think has the power to change the D&A in that is happening?
- 3. What do you think they should do? (PROBE: At national level? At district level? At health facilities? In communities?)
